


Bring your wheels!




CONNECTOR 900


Connector 900 links the Freshwater Railway system to the busiest intercity rail line in Canada. Go north!

BORDER CROSSING



Proof of citizenship is required to cross the US-Canada border in either direction. To avoid delays on the bus, we'll ask you to present valid border crossing documents upon boarding. Then, keep your documents handy for customs agents.

Please be aware that certain items are controlled or prohibited when crossing the border. Know what's game and what's off limits before boarding the bus.
